

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The Process for Defining Vision and Mission




Fig.1: The Process for defining the Vision and Mission of the Institute and Department

Introduction

Quality assurance is a key/Important factor in education. For Good quality education requires analysis of Program Outcome (PO) and Course Outcome (CO) mapping. This analysis is an important step in outcome based education. As medical education is moving from traditional teaching learning process to competency based or outcome- based education, this need to be incorporated into the evaluation system. Besides analyzing the mapping, to make it more objective a score need to be obtained for mapping and attainment score need to be calculated for each course and program .All these analysis help to monitor not only the performance of the program but also the individual students . This type of analysis is not routine in health care education. In the absence of any such guideline by Nursing Council of India, it is an attempt to adopt the guideline prescribed by MUHS(Maharashtra University of Health Sciences)Nashik to calculate to score for mapping and attainment level of PO and CO.



Mapping of COs, POs

The process of attainment of COs, POs starts from writing appropriate COs for each course in allThree program, which include integrated internship for final year B.Sc. Programs are regulated by the Indian Nursing Council of India(INC). The COs, POs and PSOs are defined by INC in the curriculum. Based on this, course outcomes are prepared by the respective faculty members of the course using action verbs of learning levels referring Bloom Taxonomy. Then, a correlation is established between COs and POs on the scale of 0 to 3 ('0'being no correlation, 1 being the low correlation, 2 being medium correlation and 3 being high correlation) based on their perception. The average score is calculated and is correlated with the courses as a whole not individually. Mapping matrix of COs-POs is prepared at the institute level in this regard for all courses in the program.

(0 - no correlation; 1 - low correlation; 2 - medium correlation; 3 - high correlation)

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

Analysis of COs, POs

On analyzing, the average score of individual program outcome ranges from 2.7 to 3. It shows, there exist a strong correlation of all COs with that of PO, whereas medium correlation between Cos and PO. Similarly, on analyzing, the average score of individual program educational objective outcome ranges from 2.7 to 3. It shows there exist a strong correlation of all COs with that of PO.

Attainment level and score of POs and COs

Program Attainment level

Attainment level of program is based on the pass percentage of the course in each subject. As per MUHS passing criteria 50% is the minimum marks to declare the student pass. Accordingly

- 1) Attainment Level 3(Above 70%) marks out of the maximum relevant marks.
- 2) Attainment Level 2(60-69%) marks out of the maximum relevant marks.
- 3) Attainment Level 1 (50-60%) marks out of the maximum relevant marks.




