## Introduction...

**Longitudinal fracture:** This is when the fracture extends along the length of the bone.

**Longitudinal fractures are fractures that occur along (or nearly along) the axis of the bone. This is most often used in the context of a long-bone fracture although traditional classification of temporal bone fractures also used this term.**



## Longitudinal olecranon fracture

Longitudinal stress fractures are uncommon injuries in which a diaphyseal fracture line occurs parallel to the long axis of a bone in the absence of direct trauma. They are distinguished from the more common pattern of horizontal stress fractures, which run perpendicular to the diaphyseal cortex of a long bone.

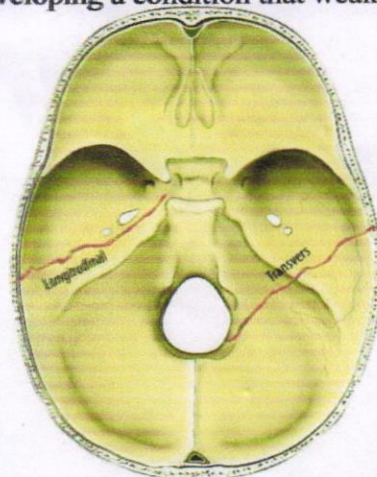
Longitudinal stress fractures have been reported exclusively in the lower limb. There are several reports of longitudinal stress fractures in the tibia [4, 8, 10, 11] and a small number of reported cases in the femur [22, 23]. The diagnosis is important, as some of the imaging features can overlap with inflammatory and neoplastic entities and therefore awareness of the diagnosis and its specific imaging signs is needed.

### Causes

Healthy bones are extremely resilient and can withstand surprisingly powerful impacts. However, under enough force, they may crack or break.

Physical trauma, overuse, and health conditions that weaken the bones, such as osteoporosis, are the leading causes of bone fractures. Other factors can also increase an individual's risk of sustaining fractures.

A person's bones will typically weaken with age, which increases the risk of them breaking. As a person ages, the likelihood of their developing a condition that weakens the bones is also greater.



## Temporal Bone Fracture.

### Symptoms

Symptoms of a fracture vary depending on its location, a person's age and general health, and the severity of the injury.

However, people with a bone fracture will typically experience some of the following:

- Pain
- Swelling
- Bruising
- Discolored skin around the affected area
- Protrusion of the affected area at an unusual angle
- Inability to put weight on the injured area
- Inability to move the affected area
- A grating sensation in the affected bone or joint
- Bleeding if it is an open fracture

## Longitudinal fracture

In more severe cases, a person may experience:

- Dizziness
- Faintness or lightheadedness
- Nausea



## Diagnostic and Treatment

A doctor will inquire about the circumstances that led to a person's fracture. They will then carry out a physical examination to reach a diagnosis.

Often, they will order an X-ray, and in some cases, an MRI or CT scan, to fully assess the fracture.

Bone healing is a natural process that, in most cases, will occur naturally.

Therefore, treatment typically focuses on providing the injured bone with the best circumstances for healing, and ensuring optimal future function.

For the natural healing process to begin, a doctor will reduce the fracture. This involves lining up the ends of the broken bones. In smaller fractures, a doctor can do this by manipulating the affected area externally. However, in some instances, this may require surgery.

Once a medical professional has aligned the fracture, they will ensure it stays in place. Methods of doing so include:

- Casts or braces
- Metal plates and screws
- Intramedullary nails, or rods, placed in bone cavities
- External fixings

Fractures can take several weeks to several months to heal, depending on their severity. The duration is contingent on which bone has become affected and whether there are any complications, such as a blood supply problem or an infection.

Other factors that can affect bone healing include:

- Smoking
- Excessive alcohol consumption
- A high body mass index
- Nonsteroidal anti-inflammatory drug use
- A person's age

After the bone has healed, it may be necessary to restore muscle strength and mobility to the affected area through physical therapy.

If the fracture occurs near or through a joint, there is a risk of permanent stiffness or arthritis. If this happens, a person may not be able to bend that joint as well as before the injury.

## Summary

A fracture is a break in the continuity of a bone. Fractures range from **small partial cracks** to complete breaks and can occur in any bone.

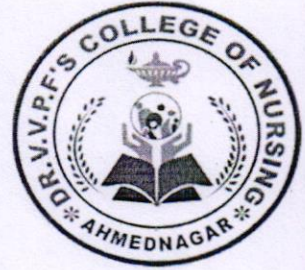
Physical trauma, overuse, and conditions such as osteoporosis are the most common causes of fractures. Additionally, a person's bones typically become weaker through late adulthood. This increases their risk of fracturing a bone.

The body can repair most fractures, but **medical intervention** will usually be necessary to keep the broken bones in place. These interventions can range from external casts and splints to surgical screws and plates.

##### Scenario 1.

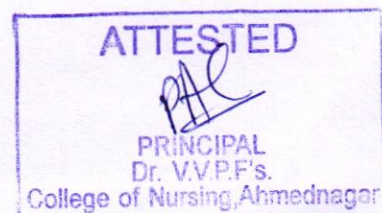

At that time, assessment revealed that Smeeta, had a long history of self mutilation, which she had carefully hidden from her husband and others. Smeeta on psychoanalytical psychotherapy revealed that she had been physically and sexually abused as a child by her parents. She admitted to having chronic depression. Smeeta has been hospitalized on the psychiatric unit for a week because of suicidal ideations.

##### Scenario : 2

Rahul, a 23 year old, has just been admitted to the psychiatric unit by his parents. They explained that over the past few months he has become more and more withdrawn he stays in his room alone. But lately has been heard talking and laughing to him.

Rahul, left home for the first time at age 18 to attend college. He started writing to his parents that his roommate wanted to kill him and that his roommate was turning everyone against him. He said he feared for his life. He started missing classes ant stayed in his bed most of the time. His parents took him home and he was hospitalized and diagnosed with paranoid schizophrenia. He has since been maintained on antipsychotic medications.

Rahul tells the admitting nurse he quit taking medications four weeks ago because the pharmacist who fills the prescriptions his plotting to have him killed. He believes he is trying to poison him. He says, he got this information from television message.

#### a. What will be the various differential and confirmative diagnosis of Mr. X?


Mr. X admitted to the psychiatric ward of Vikhe patil memorial hospital, as per complaints of family member of Mr. X patient is wondering outside the home, muttering to self, not maintaining personal hygiene, collection and storage of food, utensils, papers, broken mirror etc. suggestive of psychosis symptoms. But now a day this terminology is not used, all this sign and symptoms suggestive of Chronic and simple schizophrenia and stage II dementia also.

Following will be the differential diagnosis as per clinical history of Mr. X Psychosis, Chronic Schizophrenia, simple or undifferentiated schizophrenia and stage second dementia.

Confirmative diagnosis of Mr. X might be hebephrenic schizophrenia as per DSM IV classification 5-6 sign and symptoms of Mr. X are of hebephrenic schizophrenia.

**B. Priority Nursing diagnosis of Mr. X**

1. Altered thought process related to disease condition evidenced by muttering to self
2. Wondering behavior related to disease condition evidenced by roaming away from the home since 1 month

World Environment Day (WED) is Celebrated on 5 June every year, and is the United Nations' principal vehicle for encouraging awareness and action for the protection of the environment. First held in 1974, it has been a flagship campaign for raising awareness on environmental issues emerging from marine pollution, human overpopulation, and global warming, to sustainable consumption and wildlife crime. World Environment Day has grown to become a global platform for public outreach, with participation from over 143 countries annually. ### **History :**

World Environment Day was established in 1972 by the United Nations on the first day of the Stockholm Conference on the Human Environment, resulting from discussions on the integration of human interactions and the environment. Two years later, in 1974 the first WED was held with the theme "Only One Earth". Even though WED celebration have been held annually since 1974, in 1987 the idea for rotating the centre of these activities through selecting different host countries began.
