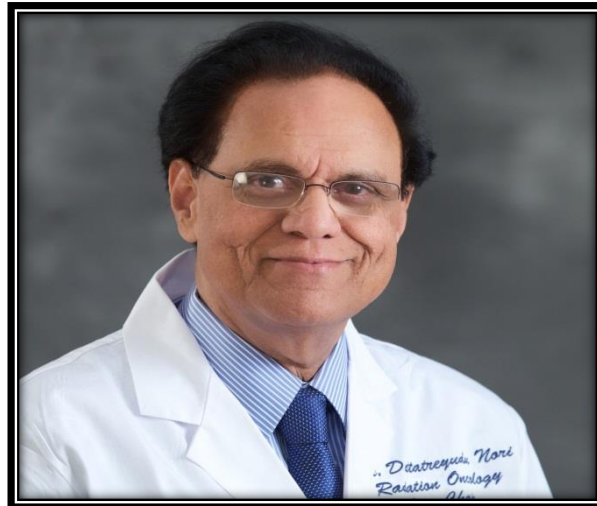

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INTRODUCTION



Dr. Vithalrao Vikhe Patil Foundation, Ahmednagar, has provided the service of education since 1986. This foundation is registered under the Bombay Public Trust Act 1950, dated - 5th July 1982 -Reg. No-MAH/544/ANR/82/ BPT/Act-490(Ahmednagar). Ever since then, the foundation has pledged to provide quality education in the field of Nursery to Degree level.

Over some time, an acute shortage of health facilities was experienced, especially in the rural background. Consequently, inspired by the shortfalls of lack of health care modalities, Dr. Vithalrao Vikhe Patil Foundation established a Nursing College in Vilad Ghat, Ahmednagar, on 22nd July 2005. The College of Nursing is affiliated with the Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik. Also, the institute is recognized by Indian Nursing Council, New Delhi, DMER Maharashtra, Maharashtra Nursing Council, Mumbai, and MSBNPE, Maharashtra.

Gradually under the competent directorate and prudence of the founder Late Dr. Eknathrao alias Balasaheb Vikhe Patil (Recipient of the Padmabhushan Award), the institute acquired remarkable achievements in terms of academic and health services as well, at the grass root level. The legacy continues under the skillful stewardship of Dr. Sujay Vikhe Patil and Dr. Vithalrao Vikhe Patil Foundation.

Dr. Vithalrao Vikhe Patil Foundation's College of Nursing has evolved as an excellent center in Nursing Education, Training, and Research activities of National esteem. It also caters to Health Care Services, especially to the downtrodden and the underprivileged at the threshold level.

At its inception, the College of Nursing catered for 30 seats for the Diploma course in Nursing (RGNM) which then increased to the intake capacity of 80 students per year in 2010. The college has started an undergraduate Program B.Sc. Nursing with an intake capacity of 50 in 2008 and PBBS Nursing with an intake capacity of 30 in 2010. Postgraduate courses in Nursing for three specialties were started in 2017 with an intake capacity of 16.

The institution provides an unbiased opportunity to students seeking admission to various courses and streams by abiding by the guidelines issued by the DMER and the Government of Maharashtra. The Teaching-Learning process is structured in a pattern that not only sensitizes a student to the global trends of Teaching-Learning but at the same also provides an opportunity to instigate creativity, analytical skills, innovativeness, and empathy while learning. To facilitate overall development, students are encouraged to participate in various extracurricular activities like cultural and sports events, practicing yoga, and participating in various intercollegiate events and research activities.

To effectuate the need for an excellent Teaching-Learning process, the institute bears distinctly qualified faculty. To keep up with the prominent and influential legacy of culture and conduct, all the hired hands are privileged to follow the code of ethics.

To develop the centre of professional excellence in nursing with global standards, quality education, health care, and research towards the prodigious dedication to the nation.

4. To foster leadership through the values based on patient care practices integrated with interdisciplinary collaboration and partnership.
5. To contribute to the professional development of the faculties as per the academic requirements.

CAMPUS

The College of Nursing campus stretches over 18.51 acres with a built-up area of 28750 sq. mtr. The campus is situated in the hilly regions of the “Ghats of Vilad” of the Ahmednagar district. This area comprises the rural sector of Ahmednagar District. The Campus is amidst the lush green shades of nature and a serene place away from the hustle and bustle of the urban sector and has plentiful pollution-free breezes. Hence it is advantageous for a calm and quiet recovery of ill patients. Also, the campus is comfortable enough to seek out the day-to-day needs of the students, faculty, and visitors.

The College Buildings:

The college of nursing has its separate two-story building constructed as per the norms of governing agency. There are a total of 11 lecture halls with ICT facilities. 6 well-equipped clinical laboratories are available for the clinical practice of students. The college has a library with a sufficient number of books and infrastructure. The auditorium, with 500 capacities, enables the execution of cultural & academic programs. On the ground floor, college administration blocks are placed.

The Hostels:

The institute provides hostel facilities for students and outside research scholars. There are boys & 1 girls hostels for the UG, PG & Interns. The number of rooms in all the hostels adequately and comfortably accommodates all the students. Each hostel room is provided with basic facilities like a bed, study table, chairs, almirah, and electrical fittings like fan and tube lights. A couple of rooms are provided with attached washrooms, and the rest with common washroom facilities. The rooms are sectioned to provide double seater & triple seater accommodation. The central facilities provided in each hostel include the solar water heater, RO purified drinking water facility with a water cooler, recreation room, central telephone, first aid facility, newspaper, and reading rooms. The recreation room is provided with seating arrangements that include tables and chairs, television, and indoor games. Each hostel is also provided with a mess which provides meals including breakfast, lunch, dinner, and snacks in a specified period. Hygiene and food quality are strictly maintained in the mess. Also, the hostels are provided with ICT facilities like computers, internet, and printer. Adequate water and electricity supply is ensured to each hostel. A residential warden is appointed for each hostel to supervise and assist the residential students 24 X 7. A separate rector who is a teaching faculty is also nominated for each hostel to ensure the well-being of the students. 24 x 7 security seven prompt maintenance services are ensured for each hostel.

Staff Quarters:

To ensure 24X7 services to the patients and well-being of the students and campus maintenance, a number of faculty including administrative, teaching, and non-teaching staff, are accommodated in a total of five staff quarters. A 24X7 water & electricity supply and security and prompt maintenance are ensured for the staff quarters. A special mention is the pick-up & drop services of the school bus of Vikhe Patil English Medium.

The school ensures the convenience and safety of the children of the residential staff. All the staff quarters are provided with parking lots for vehicles. Each residential staff member is allotted a particular parking lot to avoid inconvenience to other residential staff. To ensure security, each staff vehicle is provided with a parking sticker for the vehicle. A total 5 no. of staff quarter are available for staff accommodation.

Other Amenities:

1. **Auditorium:** The institute offers an auditorium with adequate seating capacity to enable the execution of cultural & academic programs
2. **Gardens:** The campus has a number of well-maintained, beautifully blooming gardens. To keep the garden green and conserve water, STP-treated water is used for watering the gardens.
3. **Children's Park:** The campus possesses a children's park to encourage outdoor activities for the children of residential staff.
4. **General stores:** Stores providing grocery, cosmetics, stationaries, bakery products, etc. An optical store is present, which offers various types of spectacles and lenses as per requirement.
5. **Bank:** The "Pravara Cooperative Bank" extension counter exists inside the campus to facilitate monetary transactions.
6. **ATM:** The ATM facility provided by the SVC Bank is present inside the campus.
7. **Bus stop:** A bus stop exists for city buses inside the campus. Being situated in the hilly and rural part of Ahmednagar district, the presence of bus stops inside the campus greatly helps the needy and the underprivileged.
8. **Grooming facilities:** Beauty parlors and saloons exist inside the campus.
9. **Laundry services:** Laundry services are provided for the residents of the campus, including the students and resident staff.
10. **Postal facilities:** Postal facilities are provided for the students and staff by deputing a specific staff to carry couriers to and fro from the local post office.
11. **Medical bookstore:** The availability of medical books in campus is convenient for the students
12. **Temples:** Temples for deities like Shri Ganesh, Shri Saibaba & Shri Dattaguru are present inside the campus.
13. **Parking lots:** Separate & adequate parking areas are provided for hospital staff & visitors, college staff & students, staff quarters, and hostels.

14. **Security services:** 24X7 security service is ensured at various places throughout the campus, including right from the foundation gate to the hospital, college, hostels, staff quarters, etc.
15. **Illumination:** The campus is adequately illuminated by street lights.

1. Objectives:

- I. To provide financial assistance to economically backward and needy students.
- II. To make them learn Clinical, Professional, library, and financial management.
- III. To make students develop a multidimensional personality.
- IV. To motivate students for self-employment.
- V. To promote the dignity of labor and social commitment among the students
- VI. To increase access to higher education for students coming from economically weaker sections of society.
- VII. To support financially all the deserving poor students without any discrimination of caste, creed, or gender.
- VIII. To help the students develop and inculcate work ethics, self-discipline, and confidence building.

The vision of our Founder, the late Dr. Hon. Dr. Eknathrao alias Balasaheb Vikhe Patil Padmabhushan Awardee (10 April 1932 - 30 December 2016), was Social Transformation through Education, with this realization; he adopted a strategy to raise awareness among the small peasants and the rural poor, through the spread of technical and non-technical education. This scheme is undertaken for the benefit of students coming from rural areas, which are economically backward, intelligent, and meritorious but cannot afford higher education. The scheme is addressed in a planned manner. It thus provides financial assistance to economically backward and needy students and motivates them for self-employment, to develop multidimensional personality and confidence building. Even though rural students get admission to various courses at the University, they cannot afford accommodation, payment of fees, boarding, and related facilities. This scheme was formulated as a solution to all these problems and is a revolutionary step in that direction.

Another scheme introduced by the management is open to all students who have been admitted to our institution. Our parent hospital provides an opportunity for them to work in clinical after academic hours, i.e., from 6.00 pm to 12.00 am, and pays about 13,000-16,000 / month. The students are posted in different clinical areas like ICUs, OTs, Casualty, Medical wards, surgical wards, and Paediatric wards without affecting their academics.

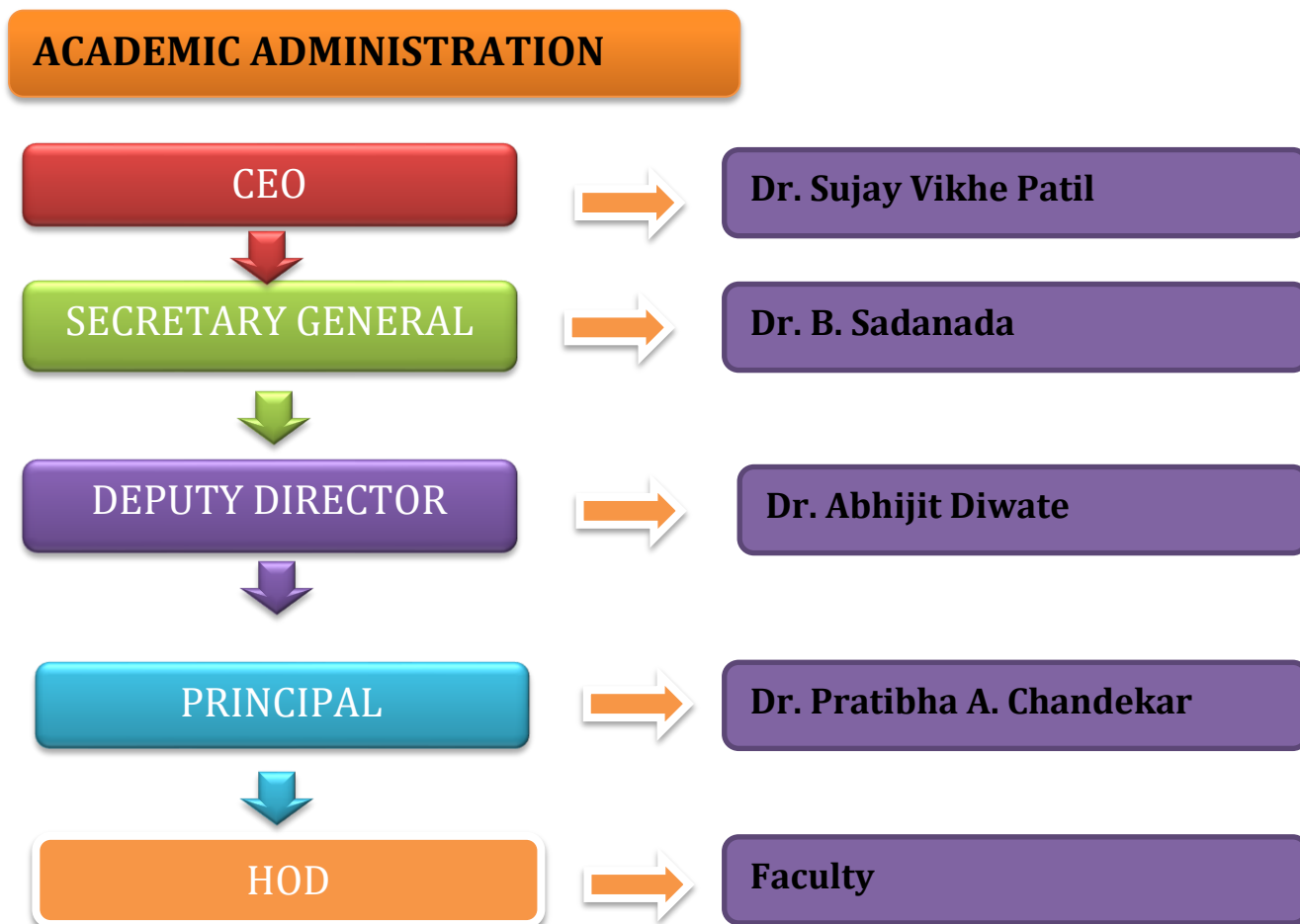

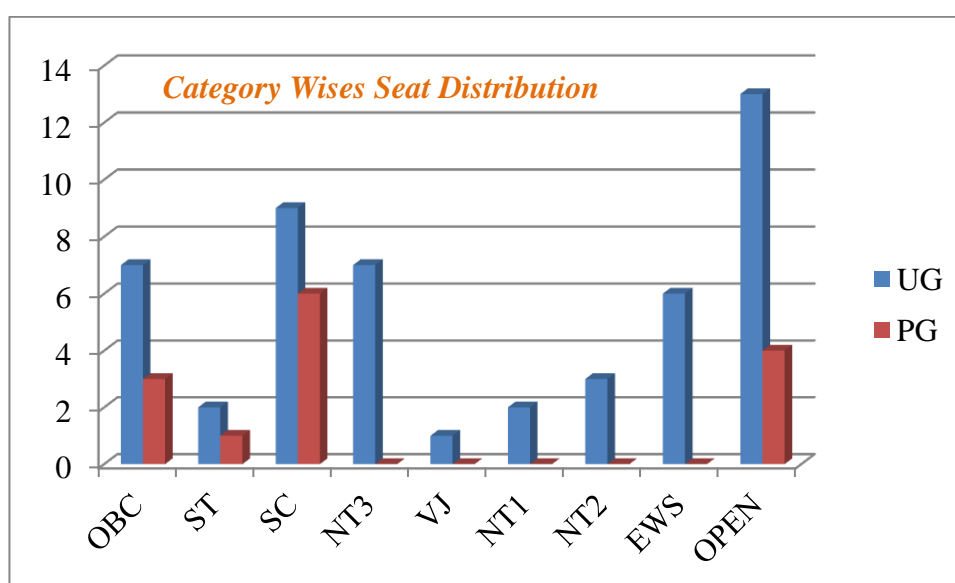

It also offers Standard Operating Procedures to be followed in order to take up any type of research activity. The objective of Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) is to ensure quality and consistency in the review of clinical research proposals and to follow the ICMR and National ethical guidelines for biomedical research on human subjects. The institute formulates a booklet for the “Code of ethics,” which explains all the principles of research activities. All the research proposals, including PG dissertations, UG STR proposals, Teacher's LTR proposals, ICMR proposals, Teacher's departmental projects, and any other projects of students or teachers for external funding, is reviewed by the IEC and progressively corrected if needed, and then approved for conduct.

I am delighted to place before you a brief report of the College for the academic year 2020-21. In this Preceding year of 2020-21, our College has four courses, i.e., GNM with an intake capacity of 80 seats, B.Bsc.Nursing-50 seats, P.B.Bsc.Nursing-30 seats, and PG in 3 specialties, i.e., MSN-4, MHN-8, CHN-4 Seats. Our College Campus stretches over 18.5% acres with a built-up area of 2750 sq. mtr. The College Building is well-constructed as per government norms, naming 11 lecture halls with ICT facilities, six well-equipped laboratories, has good hostel facilities for students, girls, and boys with security. The campus has all the amenities for faculty and students that is an accommodation of staff, CBSE school. There is an herbal garden of 2000 sq. with 61 medicinal plants.

Best practices have to earn and learn scheme the beneficiaries for all current year 34, i.e.24 from P.B.Bsc nursing and ten from MSc. Nursing. There is a total of 30 staff in the current year in that 03 new joined and 05 left. The fee structure for the current year was 1, 53,500/- for B.Sc. Nursing, 1, 35,500/- for P.B.Bsc. Nursing and 1,29,000/- for MSc. Nursing includes tuition fees, hostel fees, security deposit, Eligibility, Journals, practical books, uniform, etc. Six value-added courses conducted were conducted. Two workshops were conducted. Continuation Affiliation for B.Sc. Nursing and P.B.Bsc. A nursing inspection was conducted.02 e-training programs, and 02 Skill training programs were conducted for teaching staff. Total of 50 students of B.Sc. Nursing, 30 P.B.Bsc Nursing, and 14 students of M.Sc. Nursing was admitted.

The result of final-year students is as follows: B.Bsc. Nursing- UG WINTER 2020-71.42%, UG Summer 2021-77.35 %, P.B.Bsc.Nursing- UG Winter 2020-64.70%, UG Summer 2021-72%, M.Sc. Nursing- UG Winter 2020-100%, UG Summer 2021-83.33% An internship orientation program had done for Interns before clinical exposure of students. The duration of clinical posting was 24 weeks in various departments. Alumni contributed books to the library. In this academic year, 69 students have been posted in Private hospitals.

Our library has a total of 1011 books [Total copies-2798].Nineteen books were newly Purchased. Our College has 680 bedded parent hospitals with super specialty where our students get hands-on skill training in clinical Experience. A total four types of research were done by faculty, and PG students did 15 types of research.09 Conferences/workshops were attended by the teachers. Six Webinars/Guest Lectures were conducted by Faculties. Students have completed eight extension activities this year.

All this has become possible with the great support from the management. I thank our management, our faculty and staff members, and our very cooperative and well-disciplined student friends for their excellent cooperation and involvement in all the college-level activities. I thank everyone connected with this Institute for all their support. Thanks, one and all.
