FOR SLOW LEARNER AND ADVANCE LEARNER

(w.e.f A.Y.2023-24)

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Introduction

The aim of "Policy on Advanced and Slow Learners" is to recognize the students admitted in the institute and make them competent to face the challenges of the life and contribute to social development through the critical thinking and excellent academic performance. To make the academic more supportive for slow learners and conducive for advanced learner to achieve more in their academic and personal life.

Faculty has to deal with different type of students; some students are quick in learning and some students are weak in learning. Therefore it is required to determine the abilities of the students in the class. A faculty has to adapt a new teaching methodology in such way that he/she may not lose the attention of the slow learners and turn off the advanced learners.

The purpose of assessment is to identify of the slow learners and advanced learners in the class, to take care of needs of slow and advanced learner, to facilitate them to improve their academics. To make their learning activity more enriching and effective.

Students are been categorized based on learning speed i.e..slow learner and advanced performer.

Definition

The slow performer : Slow performer are always the poor achiever and lag behind in their academic life. They may fail in exams or will score only poor grades. They need more time and a regular monitoring to understand same concept.

The advanced learners:

The students who can faster than the other students in the class and achieve high score are called advanced learners.

After the admission students are been observed by the teacher for student's behavior directly or indirectly.

The student's behavior is not only observed in the classroom but outside also. Observation Checklist used for screening the slow performer

Assessment of the learning levels of the students

1. Slow Performer and advanced learners would be identified for each subject

separately by respective subject teacher for all the course.

2. Process to identify of slow Performer and advanced learners would be conducted immediately after declaration of preceding program / semester university exam result or within fifteen days. The preliminary test on general knowledge will be conducted along with identification criteria and marks should be allotted by using rating scale month and subject teacher should schedule special teaching programme for the course
3. Every subject teacher should conduct class test online or offline objective or subjective type test of their subject on syllabus covered till date or on first unit test and duration of one hour to identify performance of slow learners and subject teacher should plan activity schedule for the advanced learners
4. Slow and advanced learners are identified based on following parameters and their weightage.

Measurable Criteria for Advance Learners

Advance learners are more potential with their comprehension, retention, memory, critical thinking, creativity and contextualization practice. They are identify by the teacher based on predesigned criteria such as always regular in attending the class , ability to perform task, attentiveness in the class , response to the questions, and emotional stability. On five point scale score is done.

Measurable Criteria for Slow learner:

Always irregular in attending the class, unable to perform task , Never response to the questions, and poor reasoning capacity. On five point rating scale students will be rate and scoring will be given.

Preliminary assessment Test:

After the orientation programme all students will appear for basic aptitude preliminary test it comprises of 10 multiple choice question ,each correct answer will carry one mark

Role and Responsibilities of Subject Teacher


Subject Teacher is responsible for carrying out different aspects of slow Performer and advanced learner identification and activities to be conducted

Subject Teachers will be responsible for:

1. Conducting class test on unit 1 of 20 marks and duration of one hour.
2. Evaluation of class test answer sheets and preparing the class test result report of class
3. Preparing and maintaining report for whole class based on parameter decided for assessment of the learning levels of the students with their weightage.
4. Preparing separate list of slow performer and advanced learners with mark list.
5. Preparing schedule for extra sessions /problem solving sessions / revision sessions for slow learners.
6. Conducting the sessions for slow performer as per prepared schedule.
7. Maintaining the attendance of slow performer learner's sessions.
8. Preparing the list of advanced assignment or list of tasks assigned to advanced learners.
9. Preparing the report after declaration internal assessment result of current semester which shows the improvement in performance of slow performer to close the loop.
10. Maintain the all records for slow learners and advanced learners activity

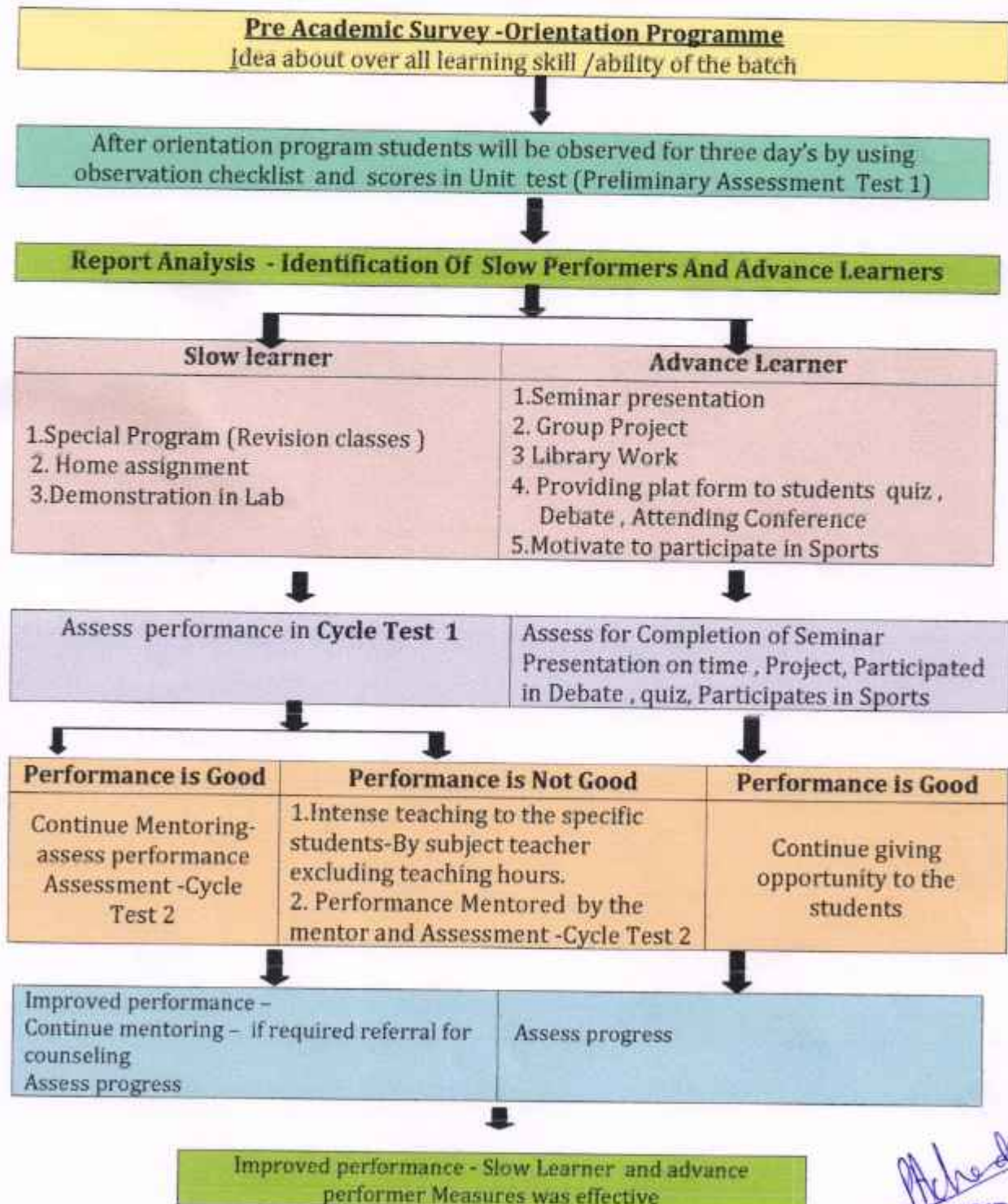

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Identification Criteria For Slow Performers And Advance Learners

A) Criteria for the selection of slow performers are:-

1. Regularity in attending the class
2. Ability to perform task
3. Attentiveness in the class
4. Response to the questions
5. Reasoning capacity
6. Emotional stability

Slow learners were identified based on five point rating scale with six components. Students securing less than 16 marks are slow performers.

B) Criteria for the selection of advance learners are:-

1. Regularity in attending the class
2. Ability to perform task
3. Attentiveness in the class
4. Response to the questions
5. Reasoning capacity
6. Emotional stability

Advance learners identified based on five point rating scale (one to five) with six components. Students securing more than 33 marks are advance Learner
