Introduction

The Central Library was established in 2002 along with the inception of the college. Since its establishment, it has grown steadily into a well-equipped knowledge resource centre supporting teaching, learning, research, and academic excellence. The library currently houses 14,109 medical books and subscribes to 19 Indian print journals covering various disciplines of medical and health sciences. In addition, it provides access to a wide range of electronic resources through the MUHS Digital Library Consortium and other online platforms.

Library Infrastructure

- **Location:** Situated within the institutional campus.
- **Total Library Area: 2,415.05 sq. metres.**

The Central Library has adequate infrastructure to support the academic and research needs of students and faculty members. The Main Reading Hall has a seating capacity of 200, while the Outdoor Reading Hall also accommodates 200 users and provides an extended study facility. Separate reading rooms are available for staff (40 seats) and postgraduate students (40 seats) to ensure a conducive learning environment. The library also has an Internet Section equipped with 50 computer nodes for accessing digital resources and an Audio-Visual (Video) Room with a seating capacity of 15 for multimedia-based learning.

The library maintains a rich collection of 14,109 medical books, comprising 11,632 books in the Central Library and 2,477 books in various departmental libraries. To support teaching, learning, and research, the library also subscribes to 19 Indian print journals covering diverse disciplines of medical and health sciences.
